

## SHREWSBURY JUNIOR COURSE – RULES ON GOING OUT AND “FREE-TIME”

- These rules are made to protect you and to help you avoid any potential danger.
- Shrewsbury is a safe town, but our staff and host families are aware of areas to avoid and you must respect their final decision on where you are allowed to go out.

### GENERAL

1. Always tell your family **where** you are going and **when** you will be home.
2. You must take your fully-charged mobile phone when you go out and keep it with you at all times.
3. Students must comply with any host family or staff requests that either you do not go out, or that you return home at a particular time.
4. Between lessons students must remain on campus.

### EVENINGS

5. No student **under 17** can go into the Town Centre\* in the evening, except to events organised by the school's staff or when accompanied by your host family.
6. Students **aged 17** may go into the Town Centre\* in the early evening (until 9.30pm), but not on Friday, Saturday or Sunday evenings and only with prior agreement.

### MEETING IN YOUR LOCAL AREA

8. You can meet with other students in the area local to your host family **only** if your parents have given us their permission, you tell your host family and they know where you are.
9. If your parents have given permission for you to go out after school you must be **home** by the following times (unless your parents have given different times which could be earlier):
  - **Up to age 14: 8pm;**
  - **Age 15-16: 9.30pm;**
  - **Age 17: 10.30pm.**

### SUNDAYS

10. Sundays can be spent with host families and used to catch up on any homework, however a student can elect to join the activities at the junior centre for the day and must sign in and out according to the specified activity timings.
11. All students must be home by 6pm on Sundays.

### OTHER LOCAL AREAS

12. If you have arranged to meet friends at venues other than in the Town Centre you must have the permission of your host family.

“Town Centre” means: all parkland, streets and shopping areas inside the river loop surrounding Shrewsbury town.
